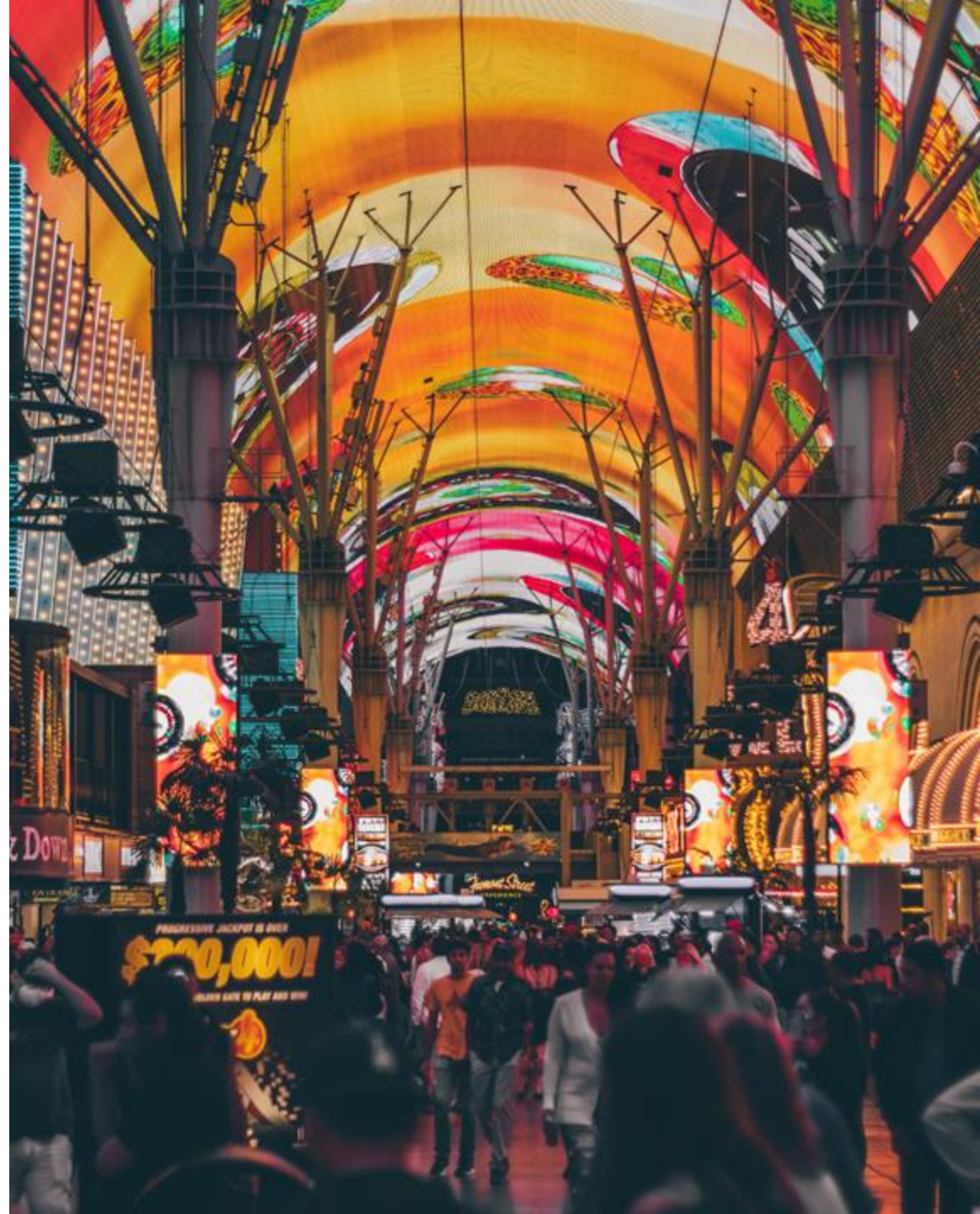
# Downtown Las Vegas

# Moapa Valley

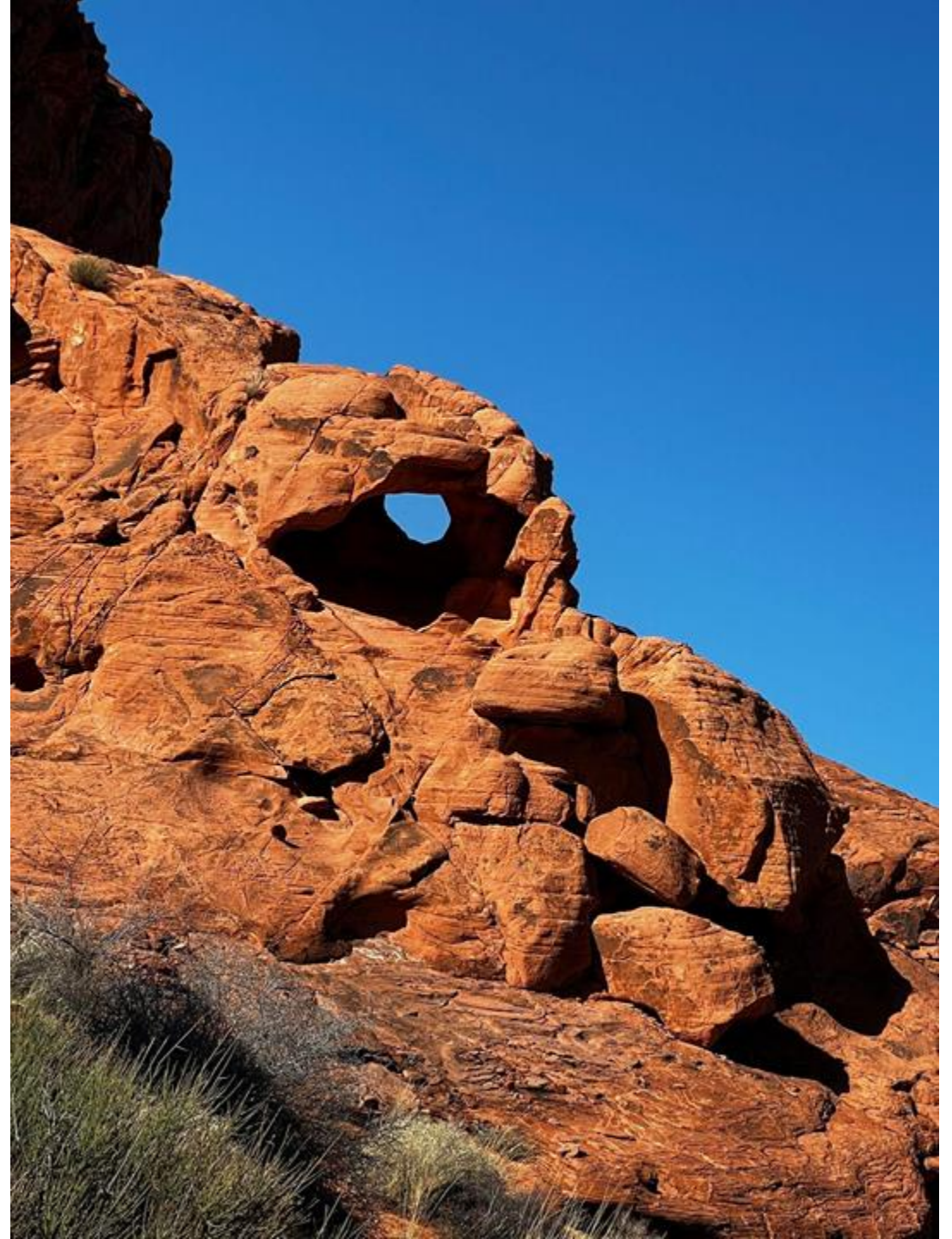

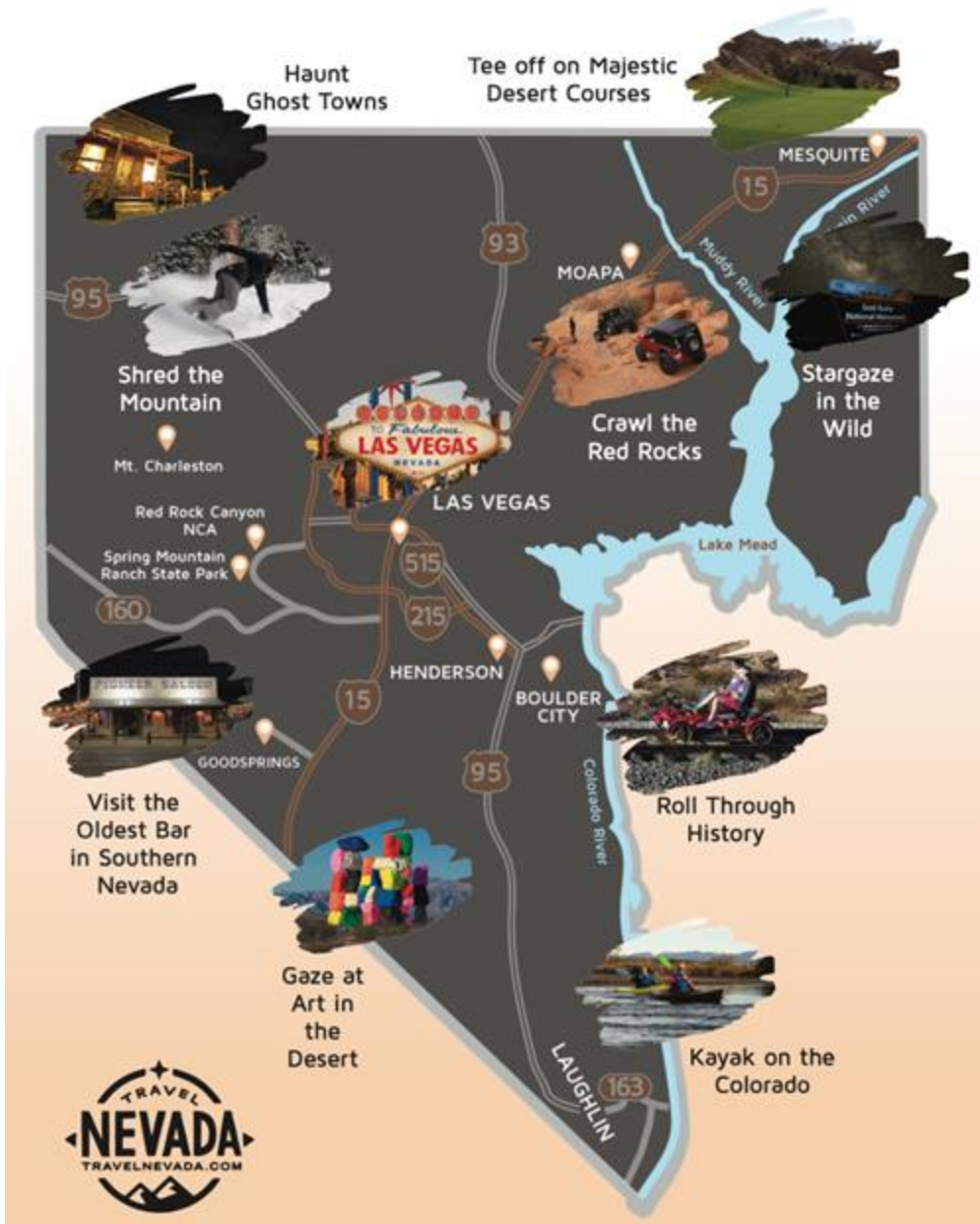
