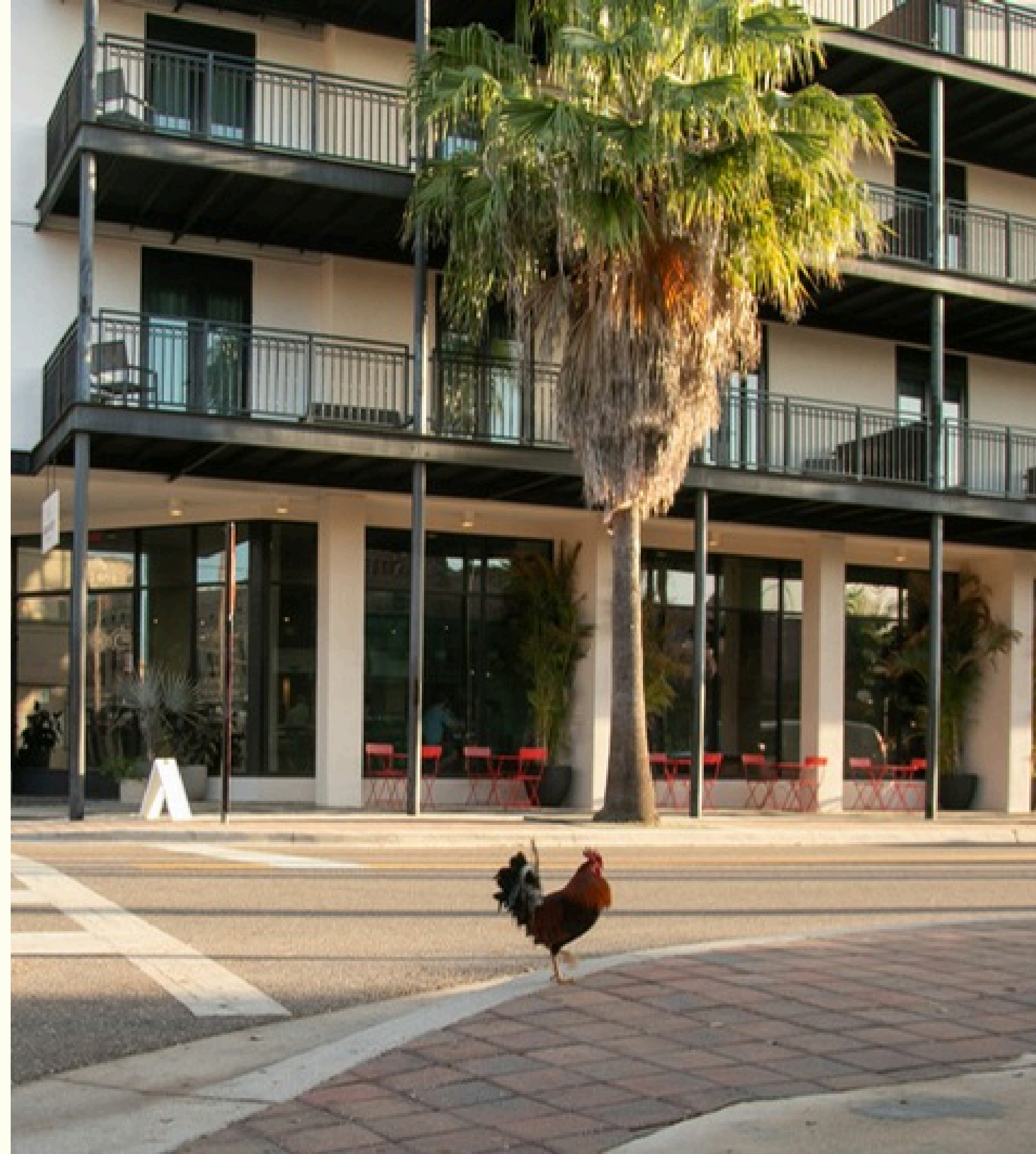
HOTEL HAYA IS A PLACE OF CURIOUS CONTRAST

TAMPA'S FIRST CIGAR FACTORY

The first Tampa cigars produced with "Clear Havana" tobacco were rolled at this site in the Sanchez y Haya Co. cigar factory on April 13, 1886. The factory, owned by Ignacio Haya and Serafin Sanchez, was licensed through the state of Florida as Factory No. 1. At the end of the first year, workers at the Sanchez y Haya factory rolled 500,000 cigars per month.

THE STORY OF YBOR



YBOR WAS FOUNDED IN THE LATE 1800S AS A CIGAR MANUFACTURING HUB. IMMIGRANTS CAME HERE FOR WORK, OPPORTUNITY, AND COMMUNITY—MAKING IT ONE OF THE MOST DIVERSE NEIGHBORHOODS IN EARLY FLORIDA.

THE CITY WAS SHAPED BY CUBAN, SPANISH, ITALIAN, AND GERMAN IMMIGRANTS. EACH GROUP BROUGHT TRADITIONS, FOOD, CRAFTSMANSHIP, AND SOCIAL STRUCTURES THAT STILL INFLUENCE THE NEIGHBORHOOD TODAY.

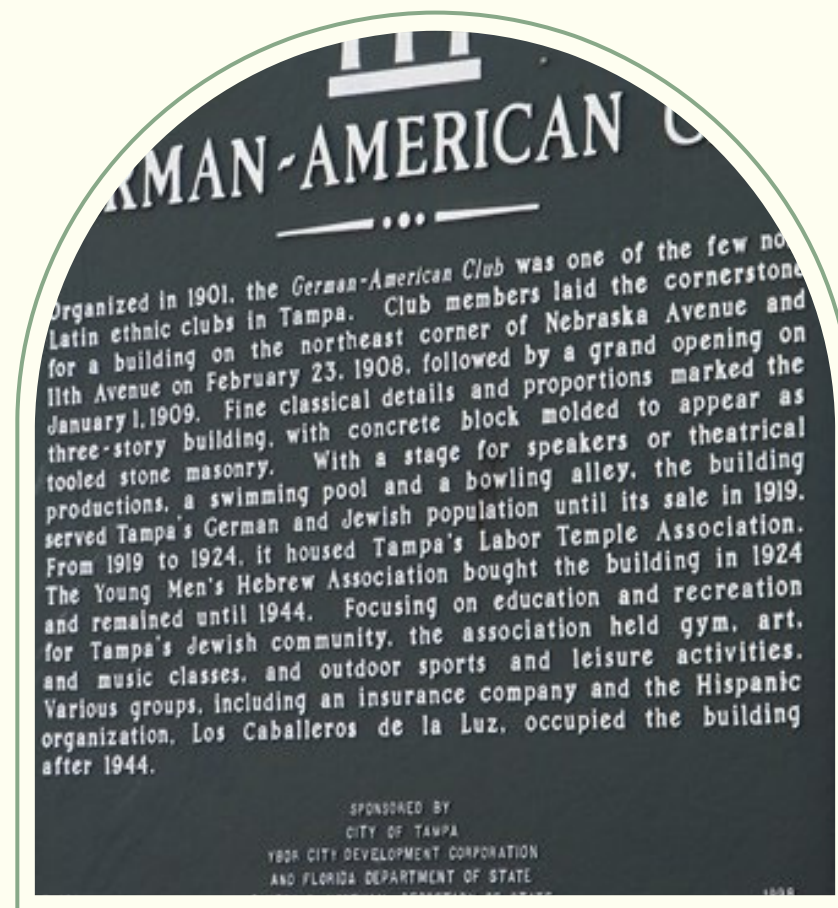
